

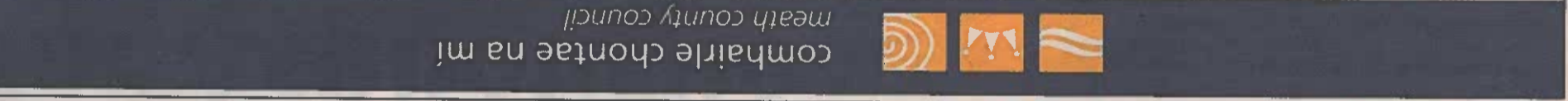
# Call to protect Robinstown residents with additional traffic signage

A CALL for additional warning signs in Robinstown village to protect pedestrians accessing the local school, crèche and housing estates has been made by Cllr Eddie Fennessy. At last week's meeting of Navan Municipal District Council he proposed the council install road signage at Robinstown had been carried out. There are currently "School Ahead" signs (yellow diamond sign depicting two children) on the approaches from Trim, Dunderry and Kilmessan, as well as additional signs with flashing beacon on each side of the school. A couple of the signs that include text are in need of refurbishment. Officials told him the sign on the approach from Dunderry is after the crèche, so consideration could be given to relocating this sign

**TEMPORARY CLOSURE AT BOYNE ROAD RIVER WALK CAR PARK**

Boyne Navigation Towpath Closure will be closed from 8:00am on Thursday, 28 January 2021 through to 6:00pm on Friday, 29 January 2021 inclusive. Irish Water, working in partnership with Meath County Council will be carrying out essential survey works on the towpath during the closure period. Whiteford Geoservices Ltd is responsible for delivering these works on behalf of Irish Water. The location of the closure will be from the entrance to the towpath from the Boyne Road River Walk Car Park to approximately 450 metres northeast of the entrance to the Car Park.

No thorough pedestrian traffic will be permitted for the duration of the closure.

## NIGHT TIME TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ROADS

**LUDLOW STREET (R-896-0), BRIDGE STREET (R-896-8), CHURCH HILL/ FAIR GREEN (L-896-8), CIRCULAR ROAD (R-161-4), AND ACADEMY STREET (L-3418-0)**

From the junction of Market Square/Ludlow Street, to the junction of Circular Road/Railway Street, to the junction of Academy Street/Dublin Road (R147) to the junction of Academy Street/Dublin Road (R147) in the townlands of Townparks, Dillonstrand and Limekiln Hill in Navan

Notice is hereby given that Meath County Council intends to close Ludlow Street (R-896-0), Bridge Street (R-896-8), Circular Road (R-161-4), Church Hill/Fair Green (L-896-8), Academy Street (L-3418-0) in Navan, Co Meath to facilitate a public road upgrade works and ancillary works as part of the Navan Town Scheme.

The proposed closures will commence on Monday, 15 February 2021 and will continue to Saturday, 6 March 2021 during the hours of 7:00pm to 7:00am inclusive.

**Alternative Routes**

From Market Square: Traffic is to be diverted west onto Watergate Street, and then south on the Kells/Dublin Road (R147) to its junction with Circular Road. Diversion ends.

From Railway Street: Traffic is to be diverted north on Railway Street, from the Soistice roundabout, towards Brews Hill, and then onto Canon Row to the N51 Kells/Dublin Road (R147), where it will then be directed south on the Kells/Dublin Road (R147) to its junction with Circular Road. Diversion ends.

**From Circular Road/Dublin Road Junction:** (Southbound) Traffic is to be directed south on the Dublin Road (R147) to the Kilmear roundabout, and then north on the Dublin/Kells Road (R147) to the N51 roundabout (Blackwater) and onto the N51 to the junction of Moatlands Road (L-3416-0) to Brews Hill. Traffic will then be directed west (right turn) onto Railway Street and to the Soistice roundabout (Railway Street/Circular Road junction). Diversion ends.

**Traffic from Trim**

Traffic will be diverted on Trim Road (R161) to turn left onto the Dan Shaw Road and on to Commons Road junction to St Patrick's Park, and then to the Athboy Roundabout on the M3 Link/N51. Traffic will then be diverted east on the N51 to the Dublin Kells Road. Diversion ends.

**Traffic travelling to Trim**

Traffic will be diverted on the N51 to the Athboy Roundabout on the M3 Link/N51 to St Patrick's Park to Commons Road junction, and then

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF STATION ROAD (L-1609-18), DULEEK,

Meath County Council has made an order to temporarily close the Station Road (L-1609-18) Duleek to facilitate the installation of a new foul sewer connection serving a new housing development.

The closure will be on the Station Road (L-1609-18) from its junction with Main Street Duleek (R-150) to L-16098-0 Father Ryan Park beginning from 8:00am on 8 February 2021 until 6:00pm on 15 February 2021.

**Alternative Routes**

Northbound traffic: Continue east along Main Street Duleek (R-150) to the junction with R-152. At R-152/R-150 junction take left onto the R-152. Continue for 1.2 km and take left at the junction with the L-5613-0. Continue for 1.2 km and take left onto L-5612-10 at Cruiceraith. End Detour.

Southbound traffic: Continue on L-1609 to the junction with the L-5612-10 at Cruiceraith. Turn right at the junction onto the L-5612-10. Continue for 1.8 km and take right at the junction with the L-5613-0. Continue for 1.2 km and take right at the junction with the R-152. Continue on the R-152 for 3.5 km and take right at the junction with Main Street Duleek (R-150). End Detour.

All diversion routes will display adequate diversion signage for the duration of the closure period.

Access for residents and property holders will be facilitated throughout the closure period.
