Road Regulations 1994
Temporary closure of part of local road L6211-46 at Ferran's Lock**

Meath County Council has made an order to temporarily close part of local road L6211-46 at Ferran's Lock, Co Meath.

The closure will be as listed below from 9pm on Saturday, 5 March 2022 to 10am on Sunday, 6 March 2022:
- That Part of Local Road L6211-46 at Ferran's Lock for a distance of approximately 200 meters.

This road closure is required to facilitate critical infrastructure works by Irish Rail on the rail tracks at Ferran's Lock.

Alternative Routes for the L6211-46
Travelling on the L6211-35 Southbound
Turn left at the junction with the L6214-0 and take this road to the junction with the L6214-16. Turn right at this junction and travel on this road to the junction with the R158. Turn right at this junction and travel on this road to the junction with the R148. Turn right at this junction to the junction with the L5027-0. (End Detour)
(Townlands of Ardrums Great, Coole, Garadice, Gallow, Ferrans, Kilglin, Balleaghan, Boycetown)

Travelling on the L6223-0 Southbound
Turn left at the junction with the L6214-16 (at Coole School) and take this road to the junction with the R158. Turn right at this junction and travel on this road to the junction with the R148. Turn right at this junction to the junction with the L5027-0. (End Detour)
(Townlands of Coole, Garadice, Gallow, Ferrans, Kilglin, Balleaghan, Boycetown)

Travelling on the L6211-46 Northbound
Travelling on the R148 at the junctions with the L5027-0 continue eastbound on the R148 to the junction with the R158; turn left at this junction and travel on this road to the junction with the L6214-16 (Garadice). Turn right at the junction with the L6223-0 or with the junction of the L6211-44. (End Detour)
(Townlands of Boycetown, Balleaghan, Kilglin, Ferrans, Gallow, Garadice, Ardrums Great)

Local diversion and information signage will be in place.

Access for residents and property holders will be facilitated throughout the closure period.

Temporary closure of L-74021, Co Meath**

From L-40022 turn left on to the L-4003-11 and continue for approximately 1.93km to crossroads. Turn left on to L-40031 and travel south until junction with L-40034. Turn left on to L-40034 and continue for approximately 1.7km to junction with L-40022. End Detour.

**Notice of proposed development
Athboy Town Centre Project**

In accordance with the above regulations Meath County Council proposes to undertake development at Athboy Town Centre.

The development will consist of:

The provision of a designated Bus Stop Facility adjacent to St James' Catholic Church, Townspark, Athboy, Co. Meath along with relocation of the existing Recycling / Bring Bank Facility to the exterior of the Council Depot, Coille Dios, Townspark, Athboy.

The Proposed Development will include:
• Road Realignment works from N51 junction to the entrance of O'Growney National School,
• Junction Upgrade to the N51 Main Street and Side Street,
• Provision of New and Upgraded Pedestrian Facilities,
• Redesigned Public Car Park,
• Provision of a new Public Space adjacent to Church Grounds,
• Fully Accessible Bus Shelter and service,
• Bicycle parking
• Designated parking and pull in for recycling facility
• Public Lighting
• Realignment of boundary wall and relocation of entrance to St James's Catholic Church (protected structure) and
• Associated accommodation and fencing/boundary works, landscaping works, drainage/attenuation works and ancillary infrastructure works.

The development has been the subject of an Appropriate

Assessment screening in accordance with Article 6(3) of the EU Habitats Directive (Directive 92/43/EEC) and the Planning and Development Acts 2000-2021. In accordance with Article 81 of the Planning & Development Regulations 2001-2021, Meath County Council has concluded from a preliminary examination, that there is no real likelihood of significant effects on the environment arising from the proposed development and that an Environmental Impact Assessment is not required.
