### Fodhlíthe Chontae na Mí um Thrácht ar Bhóithre (Luasteorainneacha Speisialta) (Uimh.1) 2026 do Limistéir Fhoirgnithe agus Uirbeacha

I gcomhréir leis na cumhachtaí a thugtar le hait 9 d'Act na mBóithre, 2004 (Uimh.44 de 2004), tá sé beartaithe ag Comhairle Chontae na Mí, ar mhaithe leis an tsábháilteacht ar bhóithre agus leis an mbainistiú stuama tráchte, na Fodhlíthe um Luasteorainneacha Speisialta thuasluaite a dhéanamh lena mbunófar an luas uasta ag a gceadófar d'fheithicil a bheith ag taitseal ar bhóithre poiblí sonraithe de réir dlí.

### Road Traffic (Special Speed Limits) County of Meath Bye-Laws (No.1) 2026 for Built-up and Urban Areas

In accordance with the powers conferred by Section 9 of the Road Traffic Act 2004 (No.44 of 2004) Meath County Council proposes, in the interest of road safety and prudent traffic management, to make the above Special Speed Limit Bye-Laws establishing the maximum speed at which vehicles are legally permitted to travel on specified public roads.

"Draft" Bye-Laws have been prepared and will be available for inspection during public opening hours Monday to Friday commencing on the date of first publication of this Notice being **10 June 2026** and terminating on **10 July 2026** (both days inclusive) at the following locations:

#### Proposed Temporary Closure of R-108-4, Raholland, Co Meath
