**Notice of Proposed Development**  
**Greenogue Rural Bus Stops Scheme**

Notice is hereby given in accordance with the requirements of the above, that Meath County Council proposes to undertake the following development.

The proposed development will consist of:

- **The Provision of two new offline bus stops in Greenogue, Ashbourne, Co Meath. The proposed scheme includes for the construction of two new offline bus stops, one located on either side of the R125 Regional Road, associated interconnecting footpath infrastructure, including an uncontrolled pedestrian crossing, and associated public light, drainage, boundary treatments and surfacing works.**

The development has been the subject of an Appropriate Assessment screening in accordance with Article 6(3) of the EU Habitats Directive (Directive 92/43/EEC) and the Planning and Development Acts 2000 -2022. In accordance with Article 81 of the Planning & Development Regulations 2001-2023, Meath County Council has concluded from a preliminary examination, under Article 120(1)(b)(i), that there is no real likelihood of significant effects on the environment arising from the proposed development and that an Environmental Impact Assessment is not required.

Any person may, within 4 weeks from the date of this notice, apply to An Bord Pleanála for a screening determination as to whether the proposed development would be likely to have significant effects on the environment.
