Re: Submission on Residential Zoned Land Tax - Newtown

Dear Sir/Madam,

We believe the above lands should not be included for the Residential Zoned Land Tax

Our submission is as follows:

- The lands were subject to two separate planning applications, both of which were refused by Meath County Council.
- 2. incurred huge expenditure in making two planning applications.
- 3. The zoning on the land changed on four separate occasions.
- 4. The lands currently do not have infrastructure in place.
- Meath County Council's refusal to grant permission for the lands has been a huge barrier to the development of these lands.
- The infrastructure, including a road, waste and water services was offered by the developer as part of package to encourage Meath County Council development of the lands.
- 7. The infrastructural package, which would be provided by the developer, if Meath County Council granted permission, will potentially cost the developer a vast amount of money and should be considered in light of the residential zoned land tax.

It is our submission that the lands should not be included for the above-named tax, for the above reasons, but we reserve the right to add to or omit any other reasons, if we deem necessary in the future. Failure to submit a reason, should not be construed as being our final and absolute position.



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
