Order Details By the powers conferred on me under Section 151 of the Local Government Act, 2001, as amended by the Local Government Reform Act, 2014, I hereby order as follows:

- i) Provision of 150m of new kerb lines on both sides of the carriageway, including dropped kerbs at pedestrian/vehicular entrances, to reduce the overall carriageway width,
- ii) Upgrade the existing Greenway access points to enhance footway links at the road crossing point, and to ensure suitable road sightlines for pedestrian safety at the Greenway crossing points while crossing to R-162,
- iii) Provision of a new 20m footpath linking the Greenway to the Crystal Maze leisure facility,
- iv) Provision of appropriate traffic signs, road markings, and vehicle-activated signage. (VAS)

The proposed works are in the interest of the safety and convenience of Boyne Valley to Lakelands Greenway users and road users in accordance with Section 38 of the Road Traffic Act 1994 (as amended).
